

NOTICE – BOROUGH OF ROSSLYN FARMS

The Council of the Borough of Rosslyn Farms will hold a public meeting to consider amending its sidewalk ordinance to authorize the Borough to remove snow from sidewalks and collect the costs of the same from the property owner, said meeting to be held on May 12, 2025 at 7:00 p.m. at Rosslyn Farms Community Center, 400 Kings Highway, Carnegie, PA 15106, at which time all interested persons may attend and be heard.

TITLE

An ordinance of the Borough of Rosslyn Farms, County of Allegheny, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, amending Chapter 158 of the Borough Code of Ordinances, Streets and Sidewalks, Section 158-7, Removal of Debris and Snow from Sidewalks, to permit the Borough to remove snow from sidewalks, upon the property owner's failure to do so, collect the cost of the same plus 10% from the owner and file a lien if unpaid

SUMMARY

The proposed ordinance would authorize the Borough to remove snow from sidewalks, if a property owner fails to do so within the time period required under Section 158-7 of the Code of Ordinances, require the property owner to pay the costs of the same, plus 10%, and file a lien against the property if the costs remain unpaid.

A copy of the proposed Ordinance may be examined in the Borough office, without charge, or obtained for a charge not greater than the cost thereof, during regular business hours.
